New Olympic masterplan Several key changes were made by architects EDAW, Allies and Morrison, Foreign Office and HOK Sport to the original Olympic masterplan. These were made to help with cost and legacy pressures. The media and broadcasting centres (1), were moved more centrally so as to provide a better-linked commercial district after 2012, meaning that the volleyball courts have had to be moved to Earl's Court; the basketball facilities were moved (2); the two fencing facilities were merged (3); the hockey (4) was moved closer to the athletes' village (5); and the velodrome (6)was moved to accommodate some of the paralympic facilities (7).

The main stadium (8) and the aquatics centre (9) have remained in the same locations.
