## MAIN CHANGES TO THE 2008 EDITION

This Approved Document X comes into force on 25 December 2008 in support of the Building Industry Festive Regulations (S1 2001 / 2345). From that date the 2007 edition of Approved Document X will become obsolete. The main changes are in the legal requirements and the supporting technical guidance in this edition of Approved Document X addresses the latest requirements of the global economic recession, the Code for Sustainable Christmases (England and Wales) and the consolidation of true meanings and definitions. Scottish standards are also incorporated.
